If the notice states "NO HAWKERS OR PEDDLERS INVITED" or "NO SOLICITORS," then the solicitor shall immediately and peacefully depart from the premises.

Any solicitor who has gained entrance to any residence, whether invited or not, shall immediately and peacefully depart from the premises when requested to do so by the occupant.

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 I/We, the undersigned, affirm that the above statements are true; that I/we am/are authorized to sign this document on behalf of this business/organization; that I/we agree to the special condition(s) noted above, if any; that I/we am/are familiar with and agree to abide by the Ordinances of the Village of South Elgin, which apply to this business; and that I/we understand that violation of the ordinances or special condition(s) may result in suspension or revocation of this license, as well as other penalties as may be provided by Ordinance.
