

**VILLAGE OF SOUTH ELGIN**  
**MINUTES OF THE LOCAL LIQUOR COMMISSION**  
**10 N. Water Street, South Elgin, Illinois 60177**  
**January 27, 2020**

1. **Call to Order:** On January 27, 2020 a meeting before the Local Liquor Control Commissioners was called to order at 5:28 pm at 10 N. Water Street Road, South Elgin, IL by Liquor Commissioner, Steve Ward.
2. **Roll Call:** The following were present: Commissioners Steve Ward, Lisa Guess and Jennifer Barconi. Also present was Debbie Ramsey, Recording Secretary.
3. **Discussion and Approval: Application for a 2020 Alcoholic Liquor Dealer's License in the Class A-3 Category – Thornton's LLC, d/b/a Thornton's #117, 900 N. LaFox Street** - Debbie reported that Thornton's has submitted a full and complete application along with fees for a 2020 Class A-3 liquor license which authorizes the retail sale of beer and wine in original packages only and not for consumption on the premises where the primary purpose of the premises is for the retail sale of gasoline, such as gas stations or truck stops.

A brief discussion was held on regulations for sales in gas stations. Debbie said that in the letter which is sent with the license, upon approval of the Village Board, the licensee is reminded of regulations in the Village Code. Commission Guess inquired if any other gas stations have inquired on a liquor license to which Debbie replied no. Commissioner Ward confirmed the hours for alcohol sales are 7am-12 midnight.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Guess** to approve the application of Thornton's #117 for issuance of a 2020 Class A-3 Alcoholic Liquor Dealers License at 900 N. LaFox Street pending approval of the Village Board at the February 3, 2020 Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Barconi**. There was no further discussion of the motion. The vote as follows:

4. **Discussion and Approval: Application for a 2020 Alcoholic Liquor Dealer's License in the Class C-1 Category with a Late Night Permit – CP Management Group, d/b/a Overflow, 454B Redington Drive** - Debbie reported that CP Management Group has submitted a full and complete application along with fees for a 2020 Class C-1 liquor license which authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premise where the primary purpose of the premises is a tavern, bar or saloon with a general service bar; with or without food service.

Debbie reported that this is the former location of Ringside Pub and CP Management Group is three of the members which own and operate Riverside Pizza. There was a brief discussion of their business plan is, Trustee Guess inquired if they are planning to have Live Entertainment, Debbie advised that is not their intent and they did not apply for that permit, only the Late Night Permit.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Guess** to approve the application of Overflow for issuance of a 2020 Class C-1 Alcoholic Liquor Dealers License with a Late Night Permit at 454B Redington pending approval of the Village Board at the February 3, 2020 Regular Board Meeting. **5. Discussion and Approval: Late Night permit for 2020 Application – Mary’s Corner Tap, Inc., d/b/a Mary’s Corner Tap, 304 Mill Street** – Debbie reported that Mary’s Corner Tap amended their 2020 license application to include a Late Night Permit allowing the location to remain open until 2 am, if desired. During staff’s review of the amended license it was noted that Mary’s Corner is not a restaurant with a general service bar (Class B-1), but is a tavern, bar or saloon with or without food service (Class C-1) and as such upon the Village Boards approval of the Late Night Permit the license classification will also be amended..

A motion was made by **Commissioner Barconi** to approve the amended application of Mary’s Corner Tap for issuance of a 2020 Late Night Permit at 304 Mill Street pending approval of the Village Board at the February 3, 2020 Regular Board Meeting as well as reclassifying the establishment to reflect a C-1 license classification. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Guess**. There was no further discussion of the motion. The vote as follows:

**6. Discussion and Approval: Live Entertainment Permit for 2020 Application – Winners 50 LLC, d/b/a Winner’s Pub, 50 S. Per their amended application they are seeking to hold weekly Trivia Nights.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Guess** to approve the amended application of Winners Pub for issuance of a 2020 Live Entertainment Permit at 50 S. McLean Blvd. pending approval of the Village Board at the February 3, 2020 Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Barconi**. There was no further discussion of the motion.
