I. Call to Order

On October 18, 2019 a meeting by the South Elgin Fire and Police Commissioners was called to order at 4:16 p.m. by **Chairman Foster** at Village Hall, Conference Room C, 10 N. Water St., South Elgin, IL.

II. Roll Call

The following were present: **Chairman Tom Foster, Secretary Mike Nohl and Commissioner John Fialko.** Staff present was: **Chief Jerry Krawczyk and Recording Secretary Donna Babica.** Also present was **Reporter Frank Muisenga, The Examiner.**

III. Communication

The September 20, 2019 meeting minutes were presented for approval. **Chairman Foster** moved to approve the minutes of September 20, 2019 as presented; seconded by **Secretary Nohl.** No further discussion held. Voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

IV. Adjourn to Closed Session Pursuant to 5ILCS 120/2 (c)(1) Personnel; or 5ILCS 120/2 (c)(11) Litigation: **Chairman Foster** moved and seconded by **Commissioner Fialko** to adjourn the Open Meeting and enter into Closed Session pursuant to 5ILCS 120/2(C)(1) personnel. Voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried. The Open Meeting was adjourned at 4:17 p.m.

VII. New Business

A. Personnel – Candidate Cory Lamasky

The Board considered **Candidate Cory Lamasky** in closed session. A Conditional Offer of Employment was approved at the September 20, 2019 meeting contingent upon the passing of the psychological and medical exams. **Chairman Foster** moved, seconded by **Commissioner Fialko,** to approve the hiring of Candidate Lamasky from the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register. No further discussion held. Voice vote was unanimous; motion carried.

VIII. Public Comment

Reporter Frank Muisenga asked if there was a reason why Candidate Lamasky was not at the last group for hiring. **Chief Krawczyk** explained that there is a testing process. Officer Taylor was at the academy and Officer Woodward is previous service. They were sworn in. **Chairman Foster** stated that the Village only allows the hiring of 33 officers. Any hiring is filling existing vacancies. We cannot exceed 33 officers. **Reporter Muisenga** asked why officers leave. **Chief Krawczyk** stated various reasons, such as moving to another department or retirement. **Reporter Muisenga** asked if Candidate Lamasky will be sworn in at the next meeting. **Chief Krawczyk** stated no, it is based on the academy dates. He will be coming aboard full time in December. **Chairman Foster** stated the next academy is January 2020.
